### 3. For Discussion and Decision:

The Committee for Allied Courses reviewed the modified curricula of 8 courses: Museum Techniques, Histology Techniques, Embalming Techniques, Histology Techniques, Operation Theatre Techniques, Fellowship in Micro Ear Surgery, Fellowship in Micro Ear Surgery, Fellowship in Endoscopic Sinus Surgery, Fellowship in Pediatric Dermatology, Fellowship in Minimal Access Surgery, presently being offered, as recommended by the respective Boards of Study and recommended to Academic Council for its approval.

h. UGC Ph. D. (Minimum Standard Procedure for Award of M. Phil / Ph. D. Degrees) (1<sup>st</sup> Amendment) Regulations 2018:

Recently, UGC has modified the UGC Ph.D. (Minimum Standard Procedure for Award of M. Phil / Ph. D. Degrees) (1<sup>st</sup> Amendment) Regulations 2018. As per the Regulations, the relaxation of 5% of marks (from 50% to 45%) shall be allowed for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/(Non-Creamy layers) Differently-abled category in the entrance examinations conducted by the Universities.

The Council discussed the matter and accepted, shall be implemented from the forthcoming year. **Resolution:** Accepted.

i. UGC (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2018:

UGC, vide F.1-18/2010(CPP-II) dt 23-07-2018, notified (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2018, with objective to create awareness, to establish Institutional mechanism and to develop system to detect & prevent plagiarism.

The Council discussed the recommendations of UGC for level of plagiarism, its detection/reporting/handling, Departmental AIP, Institutional AIP and others and accepted all.
