3. For Discussion and Decision:

a. To give assent to confer the Degrees, Diplomas and Certificate courses and gold medal and other awards to the candidates in the 6th Convocation:

The Controller of Examinations briefed the Council about the examination results and list of eligible candidates to award Degrees, Diploma and Certificate courses and gold medals.

The Council gave its assent to confer the Degrees, Diplomas and Certificate courses and gold medals to eligible candidates, as per the list, to be awarded in the 6th Convocation.

b. Starting of New Courses:

The Vice Principal briefed the Council about the curricula, examination pattern and course duration, etc. of above listed value-added new courses.

The Council has accepted the Certificate Course in Yoga, however, it has suggested some modifications to be incorporated in the curricula of Basic Learning Course in Geriatric medicine & Gerontology and Certificate Course in Microbiology and same shall be brought before the Council in the next meeting.

d. Proceedings of 10th meeting of Research Grant Committee:

The Registrar briefed about the Council regarding proceedings of 10th meeting of Research Grant Committee. The Committee received 6 research proposals for University funding, of which 2 were recommended for the University funding, 3 for external funding one shall be converted to STS UG project.

The Council discussed about the UGC Guidelines (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism on Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2018 and recognition of Ph. D. guides.

f. Proceedings of 7th meeting of Board of Examinations:

The proceedings of 7th meeting of Board of Examinations were presented by CoE to the Council. The Controller of Examinations has briefed the Council about introduction of soft copies of synopsis & thesis, digital evaluation and Supplementary Examinations for MBBS Phase – I students.

g. Proceedings of Committee for Allied Courses:

The Committee for Allied Courses reviewed the modified curricula of 12 courses under the Faculty of Medicine and Allied Health Sciences: Certificate course in Museum Techniques, Histology Techniques, Embalming Techniques, ECG Teachniques, Operation Theatre Techniques and Fellowship programme in Micro Ear Surgery, Endoscopic Sinus Surgery, Pediatric Dermatology, Minimal Access Surgery, Dermatopathology and Pediatric Urology, presently being offered, as recommended by the respective Boards of Studies and recommended to Academic Council for its approval.

The Council accepted the Proceedings of Committee for Allied Course and recommended to Board of Management for approval.

h. UGC Ph. D. (Minimum Standard Procedure for Award of M. Phil / Ph. D. Degrees) (1st Amendment) Regulations 2018:

Recently, UGC has modified the UGC Ph.D. (Minimum Standard Procedure for Award of M. Phil / Ph. D. Degrees) (1st Amendment) Regulations 2018. As per the Regulations, the relaxation of 5% of marks (from 50% to 45%) shall be allowed for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/(Non-Creamy layers) Differently-abled category in the entrance examinations conducted by the Universities.

The Council discussed the matter and accepted, shall be implemented from the forthcoming year. **Resolution:** Accepted.

i. UGC (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2018:

UGC, vide F.1-18/2010(CPP-II) dt 23-07-2018, notified (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2018, with objective to create awareness, to establish Institutional mechanism and to develop system to detect & prevent plagiarism.

The Council discussed the recommendations of UGC for level of plagiarism, its detection/reporting/handling, Departmental AIP, Institutional AIP and others and accepted all. **Resolution:** Accepted

j. Institutional Academic Integrity Policies:

To promote a strong culture of academic integrity and to control academic dishonesty and research misconduct, the University has formulated the following guidelines and policies:

- Academic Integrity in conducting research
- Academic Integrity on teaching learning and evaluation

The Council discussed the importance of the academic integrity and draft guidelines/policies and accepted it.
