Under Cognitive domain, Describe structure, functions and development of human skin, Describe ultrastructural aspects of epidermis, epidermal appendages, dermoepidermal junction, dermis, and sub-cutis, Describe basic pathologic patterns and reactions of skin, and Acquire knowledge of the basics of laser operation and precautions which needs to be taken have been added  Under psychomotor domain, Be able to plan and deliver comprehensive treatment for diseases using principles of rational drug therapy, Be able to plan and advice measures for the prevention of infectious disease, Be able to plan rehabilitation of patient suffering from chronic illness and disability and those with special needs like leprosy, and Be able to analyze and interpret histopathology slides have been added |
