



NABL is an autonomous body, registered under societies Act in 1992, under the aegis of department of science and Technology Government of India. NABL accreditation is required in almost all areas of science, engineering and medical testing.

For scientific session – I, Dr. B R Yelikar Prof & Head Department of Pathology was the chairperson. The session was interactive and helped in knowing laboratory medicine for better patient care and overview of NABL.

Scientific Session – II:

Mr. Naveenkumar Billa Senior territory manager Ortho Care – Application support, Ortho Clinical Diagnostics spoke on Effective quality management. He briefed about the quality system procedure in the quality system management. Identification of review and approval mechanism and maintenance of records. For this, quality manual has to be maintained at the laboratory level.

Dr. Radhika Chowdary Senior consultant Biochemist & Chief of Labs, KIMS Hospital Secunderabad spoke on "Strategy and activities for successful accreditation". Stressed about the required quality standardizations for accreditation, the role of quality manager, documents to be procured before accreditation, application for accreditation and application procedure, proper legal identification, internal audits and management review meetings.

For scientific session II Dr. Praveen Shahapur Professor & Head Department of Microbiology was the chairperson. The scientific session was interactive and helped in knowing about the quality management system and activities for the successful accreditation.
