Dr. V. M. Of India and Director General, Indian Council of Medical Research was the Chief Guest. He delivered the 7<sup>th</sup> Convocation address of BLDE (Deemed to be University) on Thursday, October 01, 2019. Dr. M. B. Patil, Hon'ble Chancellor of the BLDE (Deemed to be University) and Hon'ble President, BLDE Association presided over the Convocation. Prof. M. S. Biradar, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor in his welcome address, appraised the achievements and progress made by the University.

## Convocation Address By The Chief Guest



Dr. V. M. Katoch, NASI-ICMR Chair of Public Health Research, Rajasthan University of Health Sciences (RUHS), Jaipur & President, JIPMER, Pondicherry and Former Secretary, Department of Health Research, Govt. Of India and Director General, Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) in his Convocation address, opined that the contribution of Indians in medicine and surgery is immense, Charaka and Sushruta were legends of Indian medicine, thousands of years ago with a unique contribution to the field of Medicine. He suggested that traditional medicine should not be neglected in the pursuit of modern medicine. Regarding the present scenario he suggested that Doctors should not depend too much on technology for providing health services, nor should they stay away from technology. Technology should be used to help us as needed.

He added that “The economic condition of the patients should not be the criteria for providing medical service and there is no difference between physicians and butchers if the treatment is given based on patient’s economic condition.” His advice regarding the humanitarian approach towards patient care was acknowledged immensely.

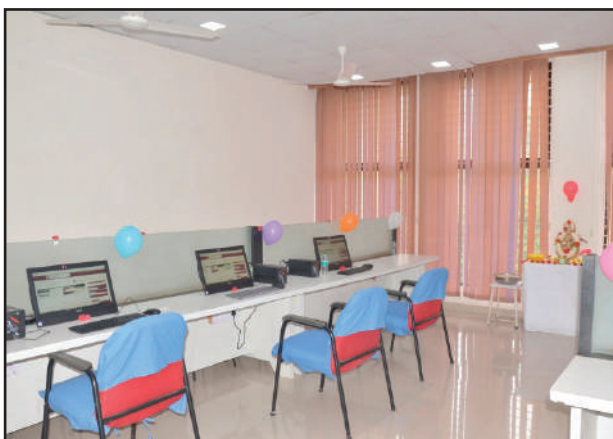

Technology, the backbone of human progress and advancement, has always been the ultimate driving force in my life. My dad helped me make a small fan, with a couple of pencil cells, a motor and small piece of cardboard, which I cut in the shape of fan blades. I took that handheld fan to school the next day and it was a hit. Under his guidance, I learnt about the basics of electronics, programming, hardware and more than anything, the resolve to keep learning.

My first proper achievement in robotics, came out of the strangest of competitions - "Robowars". As the name suggests, it literally was a war between robots. I still remember the

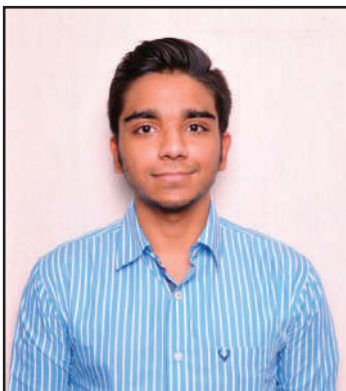

I stopped worrying about the competition and just started making the most out of this amazing experience. As fate would have it, I still went home with a prize in my hand and a promise in my mind, a promise to try to learn all that I could, from the incredible designs I had seen that day.

This relentless process of working and learning in the lab, went on for many years, eventually leading me to my next big opportunity. Perhaps, the one that meant the most to me. I had got chosen to represent the country, in Japan, in an advanced robotics workshop, along with a friend of mine. This friend had been by my side in the lab, since day one. We both worked to our maximum potential in that workshop and even got due recognition for our efforts. Working in that lab alongside extraordinary minds and witnessing cutting edge technology and equipment, was a dream come true for me.

After I got admitted into Shri BM Patil Medical College, I assumed my connection to this field would finally seize to exist. But this was far from the truth. A few months in, the college organized a competition, on the occasion of celebrating innovation day. I was thrilled to present an idea that I had been sitting on, for quite some time. A design for a self-sustainable autoclave machine, which I had come up with during my last year in school. Not only did the institution boost my confidence by giving me a prize for the same, but also helped me

connect with the people, who could guide me further. This led to many more opportunities to brainstorm ideas, be it the bootcamp or the internal hackathon or even becoming a part of the Institute's Innovation Cell. I was anxious, but everyone did their bit so that I wouldn't lose my grasp, on the ongoing course while pursuing my interests. It wasn't easy, but I was fortunate enough to have so many people standing behind me.

I guess one can say its destiny, that keeps bringing me back to robotics, no matter what I choose to do in life. In some way or the other its always at the back of my mind, tinkering, turning, like the blades of a small fan, taking me back to the day when it all began.

#### Twin 'record' at hospital; 7 twins in 40 days

CALL it a miracle or whatever, a whopping seven twins have been delivered in a span of 40 days at a private hospital in the city. What's intriguing further is, a majority of nine among them are girls and five boys. All are premature deliveries between sixth and eighth months of pregnancy. With this, BLDE's (Deemed to be University) Shri B M Patil Medical College, Hospital and Research Centre in Vijayapura has also set a new record, as affirmed by doctors at the hospital.

Speaking to The New Indian Express, Dr Subin Chakraborty, Chief Neonatal Intensivist at BLDE's hospital, pointed out, "In a private hospital, many such cases of such deliveries are reported. However, it is for the first time in the case of our hospital and also among private hospitals in the region that such rare deliveries have been reported. Fortunately, the mothers and all the 14 newborns are healthy and are doing fine."

Dr Subin Chakraborty, Chief Neonatal Intensivist at BLDE's hospital, pointed out, "In a private hospital, many such cases of such deliveries are reported. However, it is for the first time in the case of our hospital and also among private hospitals in the region that such rare deliveries have been reported. Fortunately, the mothers and all the 14 newborns are healthy and are doing fine."

In post-partum period, have also been discharged once their condition showed improvement. While a twin is still in NICU. The first twin was delivered in the first week of October and the last, that is, seventh twin was in the first week of November," detailed Dr Subin Chakraborty. A majority of women who delivered the babies are from an area around Vijayapura, while one was from Jamkhandi, in neighbouring Bagalkot district.

Dr Subin claimed, "As per the research report, among 11 to 15 per cent of the newborns with natural conceiving are twins, whereas in the case of In Vitro Fertilisation (IVF), there is a surge in the number of twins, which stands at 20 per cent."
