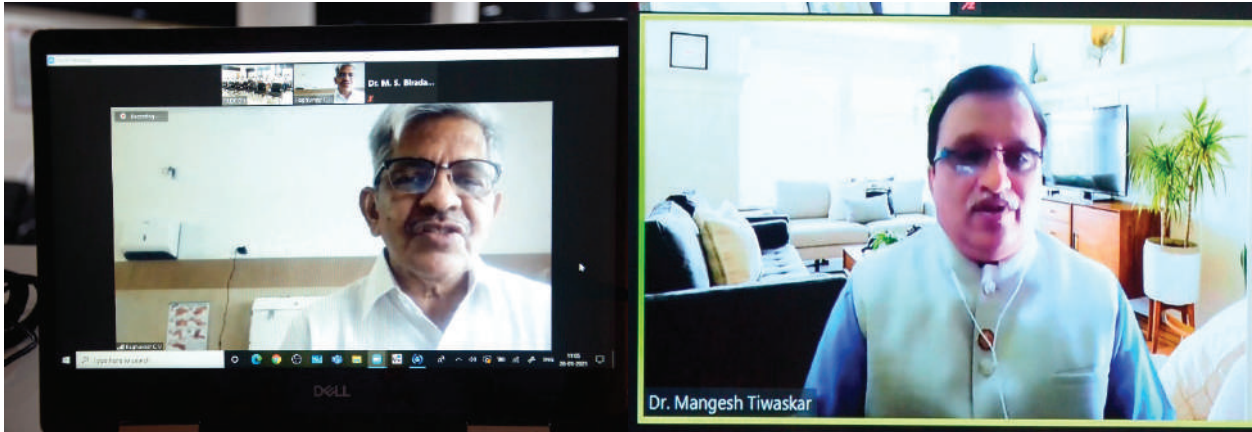

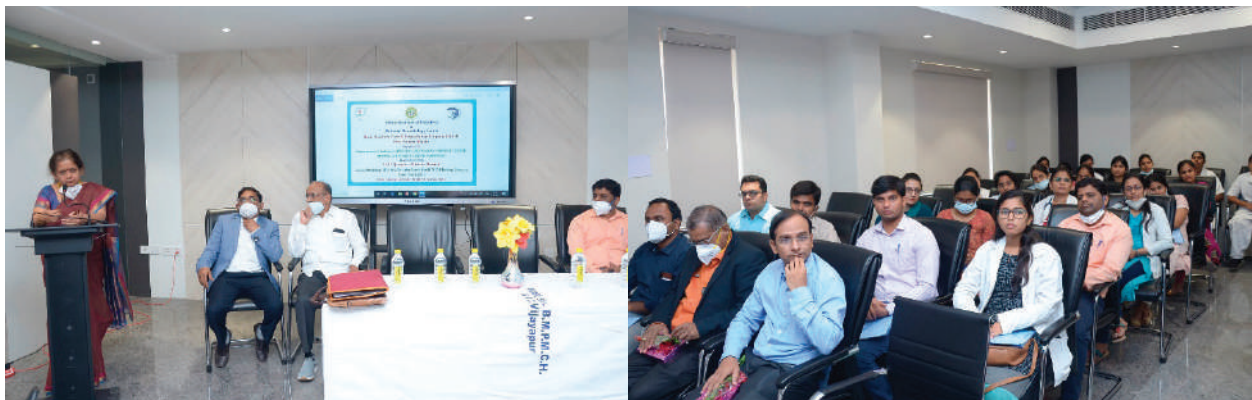

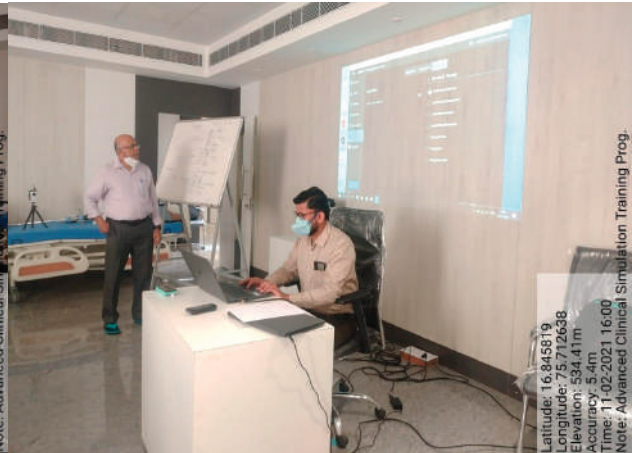

Hence, I walked into college an eighteen-year-old, passionately believing, that my life is a movie.

The bright blue sign bearing “B.L.D.E” burst my bubble. No one really prepares you for the sheer bedlam life in university can be. You don’t go on road trips and have library meet-cutes. You don’t become the captain of the volleyball team and top the class. You’re usually overwhelmingly tired just walking from one lecture hall to the other. You compare yourself academically, physically and socially, and your self-confidence becomes inversely proportional to your pile of books. This new awakening changed my perspective. I figured if I whined about the madness, I’d miss out on the memories. So, I began attempting to adult as a new girl in a new city starting a new life. Every waking minute of it is chaotic, but they make for good stories. Like the entire girl’s hostel pulling an all-nighter in the hopes of possibly passing viva the next day. Like taking pictures in your stethoscope, unmistakably radiating freshmen energy. Like getting a question right for the first time and finally feeling like you belong.

I am terrified yet thrilled for what the next four years of my life will hold. For every fest and its merciless competitive spirit, for every scholastic or co-scholastic event, and for all the good and bad the journey encompasses. In the age of a pandemic, the prospect of someday being a front-line healthcare worker fills me with purpose. I no longer feel unimportant. My life’s back to being a movie in my head. I’m going to keep on dreaming, keep on believing.
