NOTICE FOR STRAY VACANCY COUNSELLING

ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES 2022-23

FOR UNFILLED NRI and GENERAL/UR (MGMT) SEATS

The seats remaining vacant after MCC Mop-Up counselling shall be filled by the eligible candidates from the list of the **“Eligible Candidates for Deemed Stray Vacancy Round”** to be published by the DGHS / MCC on their website i.e. (www.mcc.nic.in) are eligible for this round of counseling, will be conducted by the BLDE(DU) as per the guidelines of DGHS/MCC.

Desirous candidates are required to report physically along with either of the parent at the venue as per the schedule with requisite fees (in the form of Online) and original documents listed below and need to fulfill the following terms and conditions to complete the admission process.

- The physical presence of the candidate and either of the parents is mandatory, no third person will be allowed to enter the counselling hall.
- Selected candidates are required to pay the prescribed fees in the form of RTGS /NEFT/ Net-Banking etc. Candidates shall make all prior arrangements for the same and they shall bring the updated bank passbook / bank statement which is showing the sufficient balance, Cheque book.
- In case of NRI candidates fee payment has to be from NRE account of the Sponsorer. However, this should be supported by a letter from the Banker stating that the amount is from the NRE account of the sponsorer.
- Once the allotment is done, they have to make payment immediately through RTGS / NEFT / NET BANKING / BANK TO BANK TRANSFER etc. on the

day of STRAY VACANCY COUNSELLING, by 3.00 pm, otherwise the seat allotted get cancelled.

- Original documents shall be produced as per the list shown below.
- Candidate and Parents together required to submit the affidavits as shown in the Annexure-III and Annexure IV.
- The admissions will be granted to the candidates on the basis of inter-se merit amongst the candidates present on the said date and time. No cancellation will be entertained after allotment / admission.
- However, first preference will be given to the MCC registered NRI candidates for NRI quota seats (If the candidate is ready to pay the fees from sponsors NRE account). In case the seats under NRI quota fall vacant, then the same will be converted in to General / UR category and counselling for such seats will continue / conducted on inter-se merit.

- The above fee does not include Hostel & Mess fee. It is approximately Rs. 1.75 lacks per annum and it has to be paid at the time of joining the course. This fee (Hostel / Mess) may increase 5% to 10% yearly.

5. IMPORTANT NOTE (Please read this information):

- Candidate in person along with parent, Original Documents and prescribed fees are mandatory for attending the counseling, no third person will be allowed.
- Candidates shall register their names in the attendance register at the venue for counseling and admission process; **the seats will be allotted only on inter-se merit among the registered candidates.**
- **Candidates reporting / registering after scheduled time** on the day of stray vacancy counselling will not be considered for stray counselling even if they have got **Higher Ranking**. However if the number of candidates registering are less, then they may be considered at the end of counseling.
- Candidates attending counselling shall satisfy the eligibility requirement as per the NEET Information Brochure 2022 and the minimum eligibility requirements as prescribed by the NMC/MCI of India regulations for admission to PG Medical course.
- There will be active verification of the NEET All India Rank (UR) submitted by the candidate with the information available in the NEET / MCC website (cbseresults.nic.in / mcc.nic.in).

Candidate whose NEET all India rank does not match will be disqualified for the counselling process.

- **Part payment or payment in installment is not permitted. Non-payment of the first year fees on the day of counselling will result in instantaneous forfeiture of seat.**
- Differences of opinion & disputes arising in the interpretation & implementation of the clauses in the brochure, if any, will be referred to the Competent Authority and same will be informed to the Vice-Chancellor of the BLDE (DU), Vijayapura and his decision shall be final & binding on all the concerned.
