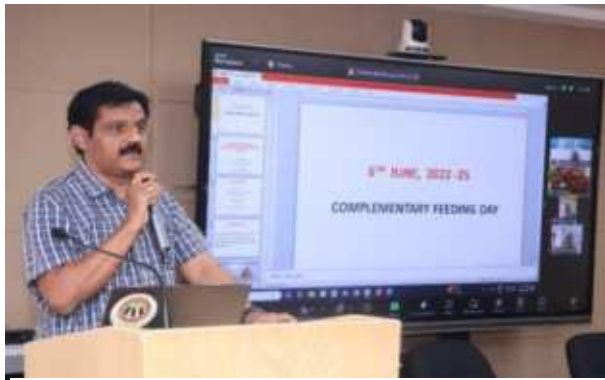

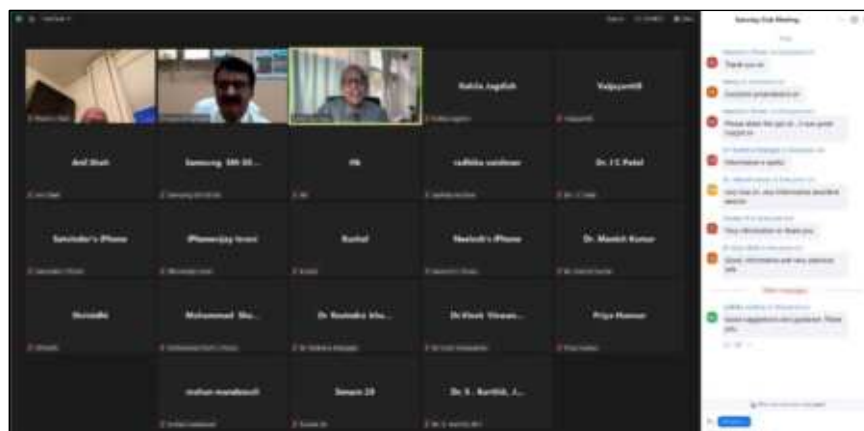

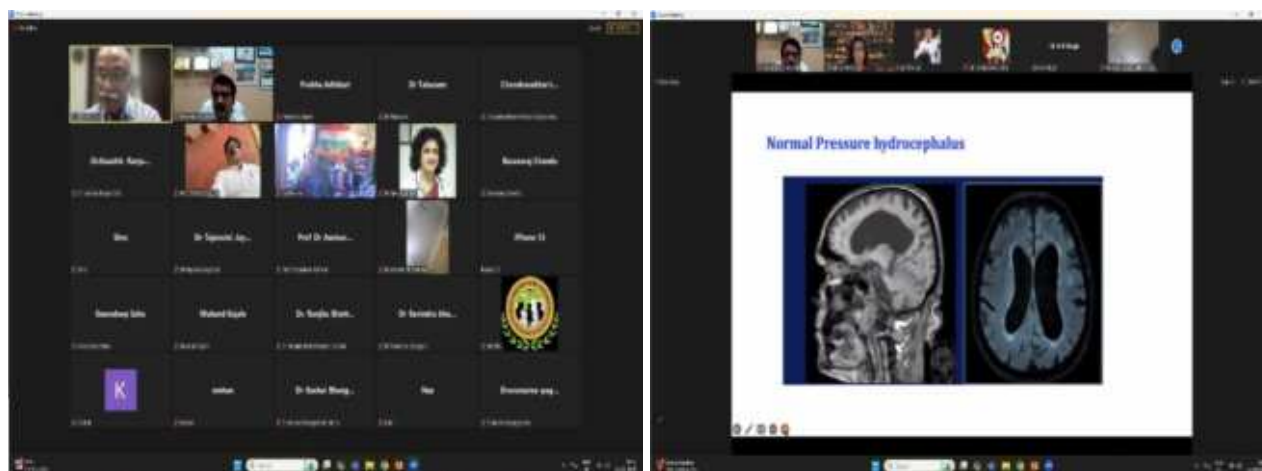
National Symposium on Parkinson's Disease
