12. Overall Manuscript Quality Considerations

- Use **proper reporting guidelines** (e.g., CONSORT, PRISMA, STROBE)
- Make the **contribution to the field** explicitly clear
- Ensure the **literature review is relevant and up-to-date**
- Include **descriptive figure legends** for clarity and comprehension

13. Presenting Data in Quantitative Studies

- Use appropriate statistical analysis
- Include visual representations like charts, graphs, and tables
- Clearly label figures and explain in-text
- Ensure transparency and reproducibility in data reporting

14. Authors' Use of AI

- Responsible use of AI tools allowed for language enhancement and grammar checks
- AI must **not** be used to generate original content or ideas
- All AI use should be **disclosed transparently** in the manuscript

15. Editors' and Reviewers' Use of AI – SAGE's AI Policy

- AI use by editors and reviewers on unpublished manuscripts is prohibited
- Confidentiality and integrity of the review process are strictly maintained
- AI cannot replace human judgment in editorial decisions

16. Detecting AI-Generated Content

- Indicators include generic language, inconsistent argument depth, and lack of originality
- SAGE employs both manual scrutiny and technological tools to identify misuse of AI

17. Submission Checklist

- Manuscript adheres to journal formatting and guidelines
- Authorship is clearly stated

- ORCID iDs are included
- Ethical approvals documented (where applicable)
- AI usage disclosed
- Figures and tables are properly labeled and referenced
- References are complete and formatted consistently
- Cover letter included
- Plagiarism checks completed

18. Common Mistakes to Avoid

19. Why Papers Get Rejected Before Publishing

- Out of scope for the journal
- Lack of originality or significant contribution
- Poor writing and organization
- Ethical issues such as plagiarism or data fabrication

20. Peer Review: Roles of Editors, Reviewers, and Authors

- **Editors** manage the review process and make final decisions
- **Reviewers** provide expert evaluation of the manuscript
- **Authors** respond constructively to feedback and revise accordingly

21. How Peer Review Works

- Manuscript is submitted and screened

- Editors make decisions based on reviews and authors revise if needed

22. Types of Peer Review

- **Single-blind:** Reviewers know authors, but authors don't know reviewers
- **Double-blind:** Both authors and reviewers are anonymized

24. Why Papers are Rejected After Review

- Major methodological flaws

26. Handling Revisions

- Respond politely and point-by-point to reviewer comments
