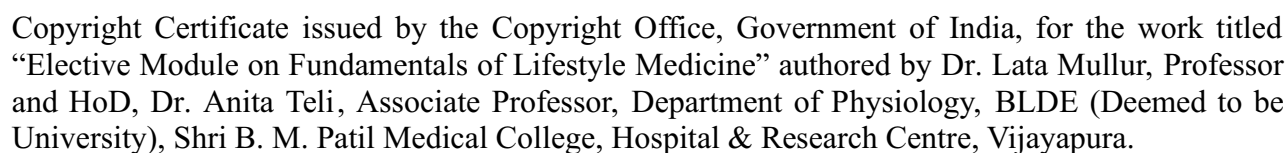
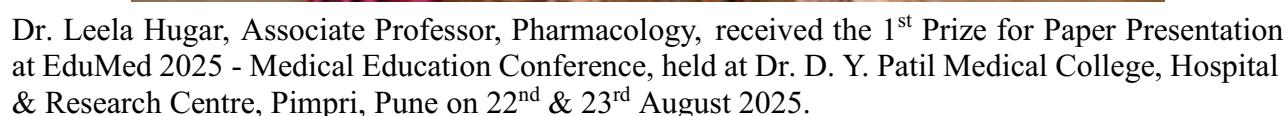

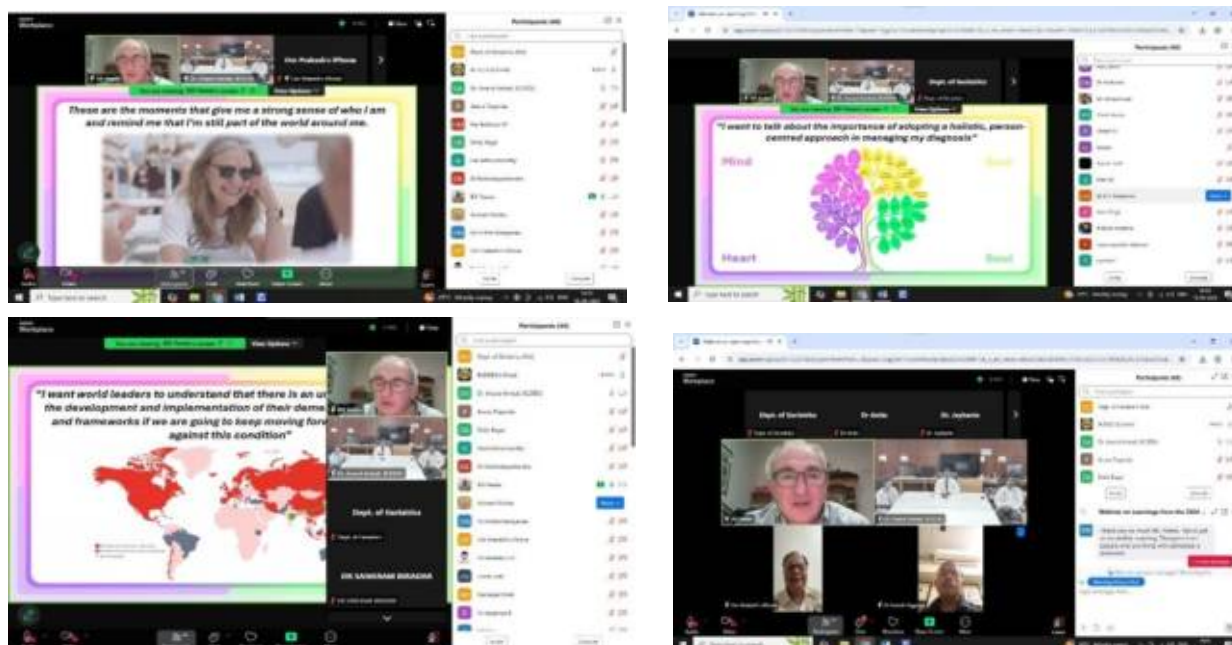
Webinar

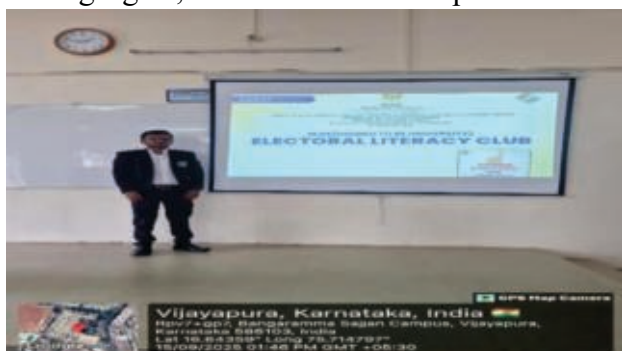
