BLDEA (Bijapur Lingayat Education Association) is a leading education organization in the North Karnataka region. It has a legacy of more than 100 years and 83 education institutions under its banner, which comprise professional institutes, colleges of humanities and social sciences, public schools and research institutes.

BLDE's goal is to use education as a tool to bring about social and economic transformation in the North Karnataka region, empower women and the oppressed, reduce social inequality in educational opportunity and contribute to national development.

BLDEA has laid considerable emphasis on imparting quality education, cutting across professional and general institutions and create new standards in research and allied activities. All its institutions have a reputation for their unwavering commitment to excellence and expanding the horizons of knowledge.



Inception of BLDEA

In 1914, BLDEA took over the New English School, a school run by Basel Mission, Germany. About 83 students were studying in the school then. BLDEA later renamed it as Siddeshwara Secondary Education School and thus began journey in the field of education.

As the number of students grew, Dr. P. G. Halakatti felt it necessary that the school have a new building. Knowing the perseverance of Dr. P. G. Halakatti and recognizing the need for the school's development, the State Government granted six acres of land to the Association. Very soon, BLDEA laid the foundation for its own school building.



Period of growth of BLDEA

In 1942, Shri Sanganabasaveshwar Maha Shivayogigalu of Banthalan took charge of BLDEA and over the next 20 years, he expanded the operations of BLDEA by establishing various educational institutes. He found many primary and higher secondary schools and colleges for higher education.



Foraying Into Professional Education

In the 1960s, Dr. B.M. Patil, a statesman and a great visionary, foresaw the potential for professional education and the need for offering such education to benefit and empower the people of the North Karnataka region. With this vision, he established several professional institutions. Under his leadership, BLDEA established an Engineering College, Pharmacy College, Nursing College and Medical College and a 1,000-bed teaching hospital.



Pursuing Higher Goals

In the early 1990s, Dr. M. B. Patil, son of Dr. B. M. Patil, became the General Secretary of BLDEA. Being young and dynamic, he focused on providing education which was in tune with modern times. Excellence became the buzz word and many new courses were added. He envisioned the need for a university and strived for its establishment. As a result, BLDE University came into existence on February 29, 2008.



BLDEA - On a Mission to Uplift Backward Areas

BLDEA runs over 83 institutions located in Vijayapura and Bagalkot districts, which are recognized as socially, economically and educationally backward areas by the then British Government and currently by the UGC, State Government and Central Government.

The institutions run by BLDEA include primary and secondary schools, public schools, high schools, PU Colleges, Autonomous Arts, Science & Commerce Degree Colleges, and professional

institutions such as colleges of education, Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Law College, Engineering College, Medical College, Business Schools, Pharmacy College, Nursing College and BLDE University. All BLDEA institutions offer education to students without making any discrimination based on sect, caste, religion and creed. BLDEA's vision is to impart quality education of global standards & serve for the upliftment of the society & Nation towards a developing nation.




Recently, he was invited among the selected VCs to join 'Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Samagam', 7th to 9th July 2022, in Varanasi.

The hostels and teaching hospitals are equipped with solar water heaters for hot water. All these green initiatives work round the clock ensuring a serene, quiet, relatively cool, and healthy environment conducive to learning activities on the campus.

PREAMBLE

BLDE (Deemed to be University) came into existence on 29/2/2008 with the sole objective of providing quality medical education and meeting the health care needs of the people in this backward region of North Karnataka. The Sponsoring Society, BLDE Association, is a 110-year-old Education Society with more than 75 Institutions. Shri B. M. Patil Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, the only constituent college of the University, was established in 1986. It has a unitary campus of 71.17 acres with 26 departments and a teaching hospital with 1338 beds, accredited by NABH at Entry Level. A well-equipped Casualty and Trauma Centre with all facilities will be added shortly to the Hospital.

BLDE (Deemed to be University) has been assessed by NAAC and accredited with a CGPA of 3.09 in second cycle and DSIR-SIRO recognition by the Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India.

Shri B. M. Patil Medical College has been offering UG Programme-MBBS (with an intake of 200 students), PG Programmes in 23 disciplines, PG Super Specialty Programme in M.Ch Urology, DM Cardiology & PhD Programme in 22 disciplines, UG and PG Programmes in Medical & Allied Health Sciences and Innovative courses, Degrees, Fellowships and Certificate Courses in Medical and Allied Sciences. The students are admitted to the courses from across India.

With generous support from the Sponsoring Society, the University's Shri B. M. Patil Medical College has expanded its infrastructure and created new facilities like modular operation theatres, ICCU, CCU, NICU, DSA, etc. Also,




departmental buildings of Biochemistry, Anatomy and Microbiology have been expanded, and facilities upgraded. The Research & Training facility has been upgraded by constructing a four-storey building with a carpet area of 22000 sq ft to house the Clinical Skills Laboratory and Central Research Laboratory.

The University has been concentrating on enhancing ICT facilities, strengthening and upgrading training (Skills Lab.), research facilities (Central Research Lab, Vascular Lab, Cadaver Lab and Genetics Lab), Innovation Laboratory for start-up, Digital Integrated Campus Networking on Optical Fibre.

A swimming pool, indoor sports complex facilities and playground with flood lights have been added to the existing state-of-the-art facilities and sports facilities.

BLDE (Deemed to be University) is deeply concerned about healthcare facilities provided to socially disadvantaged sections of society in rural and urban areas. It is worth mentioning that the University has established a very well equipped Rural Health Centre in Ukkali, a nearby village, and adopted five villages under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), MHRD, Government of India.



The Foundation

BLDE Association was started in 1910 to impart education to the students of Bijapur District, much before the attainment of Indian Independence. Since then it has developed and grown leaps and bounds due to the Philanthropic & Visionary Leadership of Shri Sanganabasava Shivayogi Banthanala Swamiji, Shri Vachana Pitamaha Dr. P. G. Halakatti and Statesman Shri Dr. B. M. Patil. Today BLDE Association has 83 institutions under its ambit, offering Primary, Secondary and Tertiary - Arts, Commerce, Science, Technical & Professional educational programmes. Good number of Primary and Secondary education Schools and Colleges of Arts, Science, Law, Commerce, Education, Pharmacy, Engineering, Medical, Ayurveda and Nursing were also established in and around Vijayapura, since its inception. Shri Vachana Pitamaha Dr. P.G. Halakatti College of Engineering and Technology was established in 1980 to impart Engineering & Technology education. Sri SSB College of Pharmacy was established in 1982 later two more Pharmacy Colleges were established at Basavan Bagewadi and Jamakhandi.

Shri B.M. Patil Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre was established in 1985 to provide and impart tertiary health care and quality medical and health science education.

Establishment of University

Realizing the importance of University and its impact on quality higher education, BLDE Association established BLDE Deemed to be University in 2008 (Under section 3 of the UGC Act 1956). Shri B.M. Patil Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre became its Constituent College. The Medical College offers MBBS (200 Seats), MD/MS PG Program in 24 Broad Specialties and M.Ch/DM Program in two Super Specialty (Cardiology & Urology). It has a Strength of 300+ Faculty & 1500+ Students. It also offers Certificate and Fellowship Programmes. The Medical College, its programmes, intake and Hospital are recognized by NMC (earlier MCI) of Gol.



Teaching Hospital

The Teaching Hospital has State of Art Tertiary Health Care Facilities & Services with 1200+ Bed Strength, 10+ ICUs & 20+ OTs. The well-equipped Casualty with sophisticated Trauma Care Centre is being established. It has certain unique programs facilities & services like Geriatric Health Medicine & Rehabilitation, 13 Clinical broad Specialties of Medical and Surgical fields, Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine & others. It has a Central Government Sponsored Rehabilitation & Artificial Limb Centre & a Yoga Centre. The College Hospital has Sophisticated Diagnostic Centers (Radiology & Central Clinical Lab), BLDE DU further established Super Specialty Hospital to provide health care in the field of Cardiology, Neonatology, Neurology, Nephrology, Urology, and Plastic Surgery CVTS etc. The BLDE DU is "Proactive and Vibrant" for providing excellent patient healthcare & providing "Super Specialty" care to needy patients of this background region.

BLDE (Deemed to be University) has a deep concern for healthcare facilities provided to socially disadvantaged sections of society both in rural and urban areas. It is worth mentioning that the University has established a very well -equipped Rural Health Centre in nearby village, Ukkali and adopted 5 villages under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), MHRD, Government of India. University has RTPCR/Viral Lab for testing H1N1 and COVID-19, in the Department of Microbiology, which is accredited by NABL and approved by ICMR. HIV Testing Laboratory (State Reference Lab) of Dept. of Microbiology has received certificate for "Outstanding Performance in Quality Assurance in HIV testing and achieving international standard as per ISO 15189" from Mr. Lov Verma, Secretary Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India at the "National Meet on Strengthening HIV Laboratories in India. The Lab has accredited with NABL Certification.



Research and Innovation

Institutional Research received major thrust after being conferred with the Deemed to be University status (Scopus H-Index: 37, Citation: 5947). University has an outstanding number of publications, counting 2144, out of which 870 are in Scopus (2008 Onwards, i.e. after the establishment of the University). This has resulted in enhanced MoUs and Collaborations (62) with reputed Universities and Research institutes like, University of Manitoba-Canada, Emory University-USA, Semnan University -Iran, CSIR_CDRI, Shodhachakra, Shodhganga, KSTA-DST and many more. The Institute is partner of UNESCO/UNITWIN Programmes under the UNESCO Chair (Life Sciences) for World University Networking since 2018. A good number of research projects addressing social healthcare problems have been taken up and are yielding information, which will be of direct benefit to the people of the region. The University Journal with international academics on Editorial Board is being published by Wolters-Kluwer and is listed in UGC Care. The faculty members and research scientists have published a good number of articles in the journals which are having Impact Factor ranging between 0.054 to 203, in peer-reviewed journals and have also contributed 38 Books and 140 Book-Chapters (2008 onwards). The Teaching Faculty consists of recipients of the National and International Awards. The Research & Training facility has been upgraded by constructing a 4 storey building (22,000 Sq.ft) to house Clinical Skill and Simulation Laboratory and Central Research Laboratory.

The University has been concentrating on enhancing ICT facilities, strengthening and upgrading training (Skill Lab), research facilities (Central Research Lab, Vascular Lab and Genetic Lab, Cadaver Lab), Innovation laboratory for start-up and Digital Integrated Campus Networking on Optical Fiber.

The Centre of Excellence in Vascular Physiology has been recognized by UNESCO, by establishing UNESCO Chair in Life Sciences – Environmental Health. The Medical College is also successfully running Rehabilitation Centre and Yoga Centre



sponsored by GOI and provide facility of Artificial Prosthetics and Orthotics. The Centre of Excellence in Social Determinants of Public Health has contributed immensely through its suggestion on Public Food Distribution Schemes and Mid-Day Meal Schemes of GoK. The University proposes to establish a Centre of Excellence in Pediatric Dermatology in Collaboration with Premier Foreign Institutions

Faculty of Allied Health Science (AHS) & Science and Technology:

The Institution also provides opportunity for Students to peruse education and training in Allied Health Science programs leading to their excellent placement/progression as Technical & Paramedical support to the Health Care sector at Medical College Hospitals & Diagnostic Laboratories. The BLDE DU is establishing the School of Physical Therapy & School of Applied Science & Technology w.e.f 2023-24 to impart Academic Programs in BPT, M.Sc. in Applied Science Technology subjects.

IT Contribution and Role During COVID-19 Pandemic First Wave

Lockdown Season 1

During the pandemic, BLDE (DU) had to shut down its classrooms, and many students had to access classes from their homes. The online virtual class implementation was planned and was live in just a week. BLDE (DU) thoroughly trained the students and faculty to set up an interactive session conducted online. Detailed step-by-step user guides (softcopy/video SOP) were prepared and sent to all the stakeholders.

BLDE (DU) implemented virtual classrooms through multiple platforms (Microsoft Teams, Google classroom, Microsoft assessment forms, and live lectures) with two-way real-time interaction with audio and video. Students also received the recorded presentation after the class for revision. The recorded classes also had a transcription of the speech. These texts became readymade notes for students.

BLDE (DU)'s virtual classroom model was a great success, and a similar implementation was extended for students studying in other medical colleges and universities for free. Around 1,520 students from other institutions registered and joined our online classes.

The system comprising custom-divided batches and various learning groups made this a very versatile learning management system. The clarity of presentation and interaction was rated excellent by the participants.



Lockdown Season 2

Technology/Design

- Lab reports were digitally visualized through HIMS.



A wide range of speciality services is provided in General Medicine, General Surgery, Paediatric, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Psychiatry, Chest & TB, Dermatology, Ophthalmology, ENT, Orthopedics and Dentistry. Super Specialty services are provided in Urology, Nephrology, Neurology & Neurosurgery, Cardiology, Surgical/ Medical Gastroenterology and Neonatology. The service laboratories for Pathology, Biochemistry & Microbiology support investigations and diagnostic services through the Radiology department. 





Guest House



Campus Ecosystem

As part of the Green Initiative, the University has given importance in creating and maintaining a sustainable and green campus

- With over 6500 trees, the campus is well-covered with green shrubs & ornamental plants belonging to 48 species. Tree plantation is an ongoing activity undertaken to promote a green campus.
- Focusing on alternative/ renewable energy, a 3300 kW solar power plant has also been installed to supply green power to the grid. Solar water heating systems are provided for hot water requirements on the campus.
- Biogas plant and vermicomposting unit are also added to the premises.
- A 450 KLD capacity sewage treatment plant has been operating to treat entire sewage generated on campus. Most of the treated water is recycled and used for gardening; the excess is discharged through the municipal drainage system.
- The water supplied by the Municipal Corporation is used for drinking after purification. A set of 'Water Purifiers' is installed at convenient locations.
- Energy-efficient light fittings have been installed at some of the places.
- The composting pit is provided for converting dry plant leaves and other bio-wastes to manure, which is later used for gardening.
- A separate effluent treatment plant has been installed to treat non-domestic wastewater. A part of the treated water is then recycled and used for gardening; the excess is discharged through the municipal system.
- E-Waste Management:** All electronic wastes are segregated and recycled. The remaining waste is handed over to a state government-licensed E-waste Management Organization for proper and safe disposal.
- Battery Powered Vehicle:** There are a total of three E-(Battery Powered) Vehicles on campus, one dedicated for student and staff transportation, the others used for cargo transportation.
- Pedestrian-Friendly Pathways:** With multiple entrances, all the pathways on the premises are pedestrian friendly.
- Ban on plastics:** The usage of single-use and other plastics is banned on the campus premises.
- Clean and green campus recognitions/ awards:** Adequate ventilation in the campus maintains the level of carbon dioxide and volatile organic matter contents under the permissible limit.




In and Around Vijayapura City


Vijayapura (formerly Bijapur), a historic city, was once the capital of Adilshahis. It has architectural marvels like the world-famous Gol Gumbaz and Ibrahim Rouza.

- Nearby to Vijayapura lies the Chalukyan capital, Badami, known for its infamous cave temples. Another historical site is Aihole and Pattadakal, a prominent heritage of temples.
- Being the district headquarters, Vijayapura has all the amenities of a metropolis without hassles. The city is less crowded and is calm & safe.
- One can reach Vijayapura by road in an overnight journey from Bengaluru, Mumbai and Hyderabad


