State-Level CME on “Smart Health: The AI Revolution in Public Health”

The Department of Community Medicine, Shri B. M. Patil Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, BLDE (Deemed to be University), Vijayapura, organized a State-Level Continuing Medical Education (CME) Programme titled “**Smart Health: The AI Revolution in Public Health**” on 1st December 2025 at the Medical Education Unit Hall, BLDE Hospital, Vijayapura. The program was organized under the leadership of **Dr. Rekha Udgiri**, Professor & HoD, who served as the Organizing Chairman, and **Dr. Pooja Todalabagi**, Assistant Professor, who served as the Organizing Secretary.

The program aimed to enhance knowledge and practical skills in AI-based healthcare applications. A total of **30 participants** from various institutions across Karnataka attended the hands-on training program.

Objectives of CME

- To introduce AI applications in public health.
- To demonstrate AI-based screening tools (eye, ear, breast, cardiac, diabetic foot).
- To provide hands-on training in AI tools.
- To discuss evidence generation and ethical considerations.
- To build capacity in integrating Software as a Medical Device (SaMD).

Workshop on Computational Drug Design and Molecular Simulation

A two-day Workshop on Computational Drug Design and Molecular Simulation was organized on 22nd and 23rd December 2025, by the Center of Advanced Medical Research (CAMR) in collaboration with the School of Applied Science & Technology, BLDE (Deemed to be University), Vijayapura. The workshop witnessed active participation from faculty members and students from various colleges.

- To demonstrate molecular docking using open-source tools and Flare software.
- To familiarize participants with binding site prediction, ADME-Tox evaluation, and molecular dynamics simulations.
- To promote interdisciplinary learning and research collaboration.






