The procedure is structured across five phases — Call for Proposal & Submission, Review and Evaluation, Award and Disbursement, Compliance and Monitoring, and Closure — with a defined timeline and designated responsible authorities at each stage, ensuring accountability and efficiency in the management of intramural research funding.
