Report on: 3 Minute Thesis (3MT) Presentation Competition – 2026

The Research & Development Cell, BLDE (Deemed to be University), Shri B. M. Patil Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Vijayapura, successfully organized the **3 Minute Thesis (3MT) Presentation Competition – 2026** on **16th May 2026** from **10:30 AM to 01:30 PM** at the **Medical Education Hall, BLDE (DU)**.

The competition was conducted with the objective of encouraging postgraduate students and Ph.D. scholars to effectively communicate their research work to a non-specialist audience within a concise duration of three minutes using a single static slide. The event provided an excellent platform for participants to enhance their scientific communication, presentation, and public speaking skills.

As per the guidelines of the competition, participants were required to present their research using only one static PowerPoint slide without animations, videos, or props. The presentations were judged based on comprehension, research significance, clarity of communication, audience engagement, and overall presentation effectiveness.

Due to the overwhelming response and large number of registrations received from various departments, the participants were divided into **three batches** for the smooth conduct of the competition. Separate venues were allotted for each batch as follows:

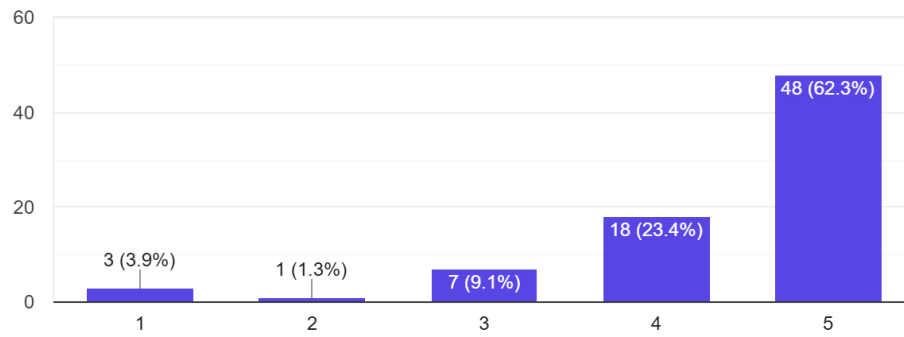

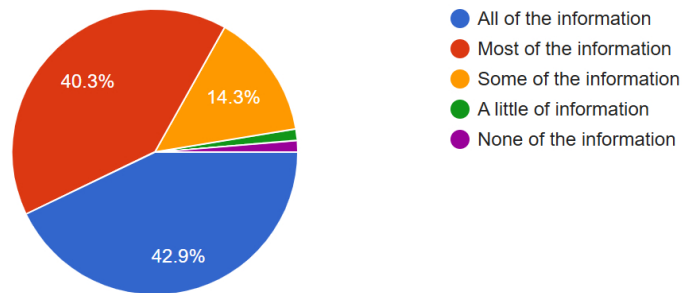
