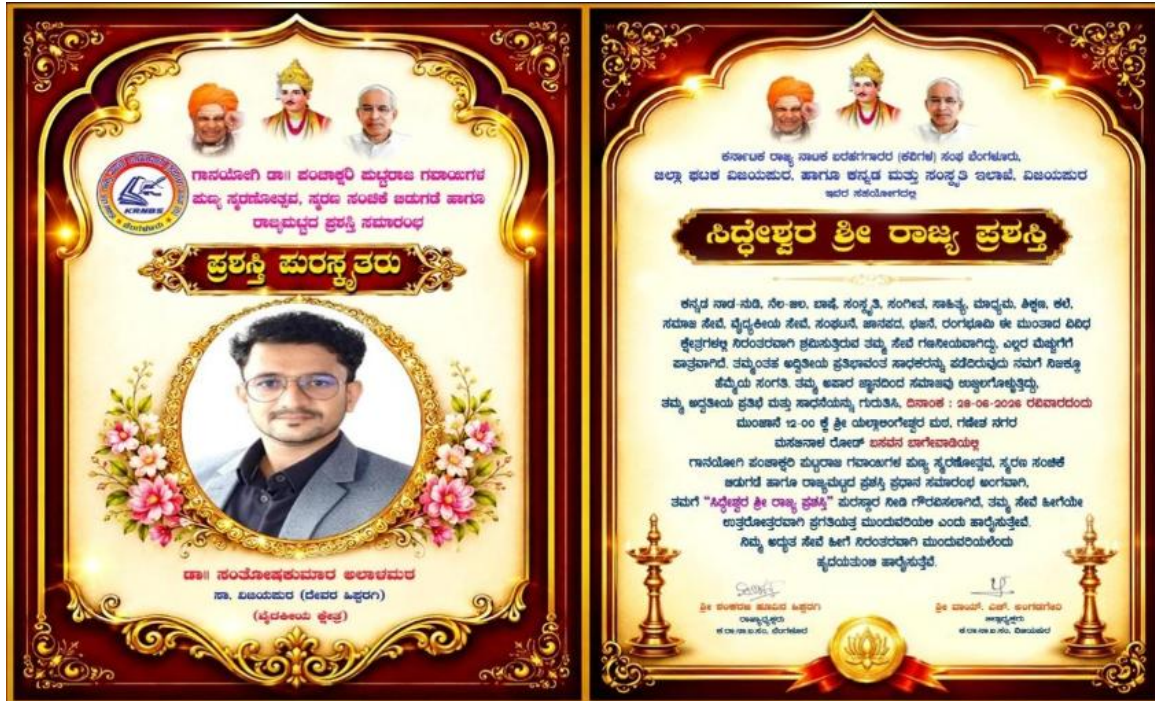

AHA-Certified BLS & ACLS Provider Course

The Clinical Skills Laboratory and Simulation Lab, BLDE (Deemed to be University), Vijayapura, organized an American Heart Association (AHA)-certified Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Provider Course for first-year postgraduate students of clinical departments (2025 batch) from 4th to 12th May 2026 at the 4th Floor Lecture Hall of the Clinical Skills Laboratory.

A total of 124 postgraduate students participated in the programme. The course provided hands-on training in BLS and ACLS protocols, including CPR, AED use, airway management, cardiac arrest management, and high-performance resuscitation team skills through simulation-based learning and skill stations. The programme was successfully conducted under the guidance of certified instructors.

BLS & ACLS Training Programme

The Clinical Skills Laboratory of BLDE (Deemed to be University), Shri B. M. Patil Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Vijayapura, successfully organized a two-day Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Training Programme for first-year postgraduate students of Pre- and Para-Clinical departments (2025 batch) on 21st and 22nd April 2026. The programme was coordinated under the guidance of Dr. Santoshkumar Karjagi, Clinical Skills Laboratory. A total of 33 postgraduate students actively participated in the training.

The BLS training was conducted by Dr. Shivanand L. K., Dr. Santosh Alalamath, Dr. Vijaykumar Patil, Dr. Preeti Malpure, and Dr. Mohan, who provided hands-on training in adult, pediatric, and infant CPR, AED usage, bag-mask ventilation, choking management, and team-based resuscitation skills.

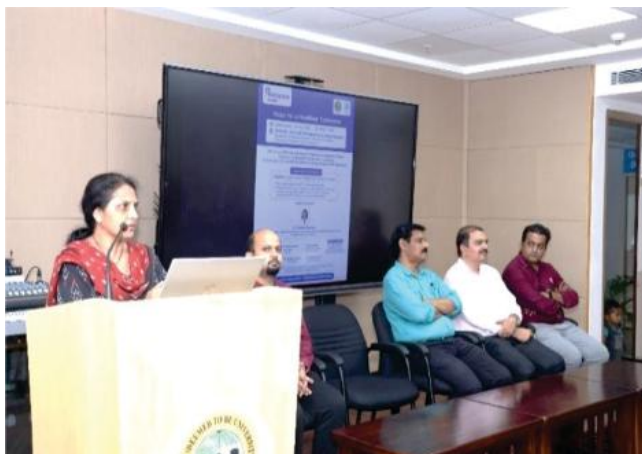

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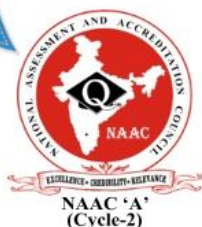
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
